The activities vary and have been designed to engage Early Years Children and those who, under normal circumstances, would be attending Reception or Year 1 classes.




This pack also helps to contribute towards the seven areas of learning and development that are laid out in the Early Years Foundation Stage Framework.





In an open area, either indoors or in your garden, crawl along the floor like your favourite animal, can you make the noise of your favourite animal?

Create an opening between your legs and ask your little one to crawl through the space (this will help aid their spatial awareness skills).

Give your little one something to balance on their backs as they crawl around an open area in different directions and speeds.

Activity 4 – Shape Work

Using some cardboard/paper-based recycling items, draw around some household shapes and, assist your little one to cut them out.

Then, mix all of the shapes up, ask your little one to retrieve a certain shape and put it on a designated target point.
